

**RESOLUTION 25-6**

JACKSON TOWNSHIP OF MORGAN COUNTY, INDIANA

SEPTEMBER 25, 2025

**RESOLUTION IN FAVOR OF PROVIDING MONEY FOR THE IMPROVEMENT AND  
MAINTENANCE OF ROADS AND INFRASTRUCTURE  
THROUGH THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
FOR THE ALLOCATION OF FUNDS  
FROM THE TOWNSHIP ROAD AND INFRASTRUCTURE FUND**

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § IC 36-6-10-3 states that a township must adopt a resolution in favor of providing money for the improvement and maintenance of roads and infrastructure by entering into a written memorandum of understanding with a city, town, or county, as applicable; and

WHEREAS, the Jackson Township Board of Trustees recognizes the requirement to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Morgan County and/or the town of Morgantown, enabling the township to provide potential funding for road and infrastructure improvements; and

WHEREAS, the township board must adopt a resolution to provide money for the improvement and maintenance of roads and infrastructure within Jackson Township of Morgan County as determined by the Capital Improvement Plan of the township;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Jackson Township Board of Trustees, that:

Section 1. Pursuant to Indiana Code § IC 36-6-10-4, the transfer of funds from the Township's Road and Infrastructure Fund to the city, town, or county for the purpose of bidding out projects that are:

- (1) for the improvement of roads and infrastructure within the township's boundaries; and
- (2) approved by the township.

Section 2. Funds used for a project under this section must be used solely for projects for roads and infrastructure that are within the township's boundaries.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.

BE IT RESOLVED that the establishment of a Memorandum of Understanding with the county or town for the improvement of roads and infrastructure, is duly ADOPTED by the following vote of the members of the Jackson Township of Morgan County Board of Trustees this 25th day of September 2025.
