Opened meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance

Mark Sighting moved to adopt the minutes of the January 29, 2026 meeting, Tom Carter 2nd the motion, passed 3-0

Discussion on the bills moving through the Indiana Legislature that effect Townships. Possibility of the House and Senate bills being merged together. SB270 seems to be moving quicker than HB1315. Daniel stated that the language of SB270 as it stands now he believes, would have no effect on Jackson Township.

Matt Davidson stated that there is a discrepancy of \$100.00 in the 2025 Annual Financial Report for Jackson Township. He has discussed this with the state and the state believes it may be due to vacancies in offices of the Township for withholding taxes for salaries. The official at Indiana Gateway advised to submit the report.

Tom Carter moved to accept the 2025 Annual Financial report, Daniel Eberle 2nd the motion, passed 3-0

Discussion about rainy day funds being used for other budget items, specifically the interest being earned on the Certificate of deposit the township has and where that interest should be posted in the township ledger and under which fund. Matt advised he would check with the state and report back.

Mark Sighting stated he believed the money could be moved to a different budget line item through an additional appropriation approved by the advisory board members

Tom Carter moved to adjourn the meeting, Daniel Eberle 2nd, passed 3-0
